**CCI/Russia Code of Interconfessional Conduct**  
**TO BE OBSERVED AT ALL CCI/RUSSIA EVENTS**

Jesus Christ is the head of the church. He died and rose from the dead to establish the church for His glory. Therefore we regard the church as sacred and do not criticize it but respect it as the body of Christ.

Every confession (denomination), though organized by man, sees itself as doctrinally correct and balanced. All confessions are based on doctrinal distinctives, which express themselves in various practices. But man is fallible and sinful; therefore no confession is perfect – all have strengths and flaws. So they differ from one another.

Distinctives express themselves in forms of dress, styles of prayer, observances of special days, methods of worship, ways of singing and playing music, eating habits, abstinence from certain practices, regulations, policies, etc. The practice of confessional distinctives during CCI/Russia functions tends to divide. But Jesus has prayed for our unity (John 17: 20-23).

As an interconfessional organization, CCI/Russia seeks to serve all confessions that are based on the Holy Scriptures and focused on Jesus Christ. We ask all committee and board members, instructors, leaders and all who participate in our functions to express their respect for each confession by not drawing attention to the distinctives of their own confession. We ask that no one criticize or pass judgment on their own or any other confession.

We encourage all to relate to one another in the spirit of Acts 10:1 - 11:18. We ask that all be considerate towards one another by rejoicing in what we have in common and by not taking offense by the beliefs and practices that differ from our own. We ask that no one teaches their distinctives or in any way draws attention to them but rather focuses on the beliefs and practices we have in common for the common good. We ask that you do not judge other believer's expression of faith but rather examine yourself (Matthew 7:1-5).

By fulfilling these requests, you will be open to receive the blessings God has in store for you at CCI/Russia event.

By signing this CCI/Russia Code of Interconfessional Conduct, you are assuring the CCI family that you have prayerfully considered this code and agree to conduct yourself accordingly. Your signature also indicates your agreement with and support of the CCI/Russia Creed. We thank you for your co-operation and look forward to having fellowship and serving the Lord Jesus Christ with you.
